### **Introducing Dr. Arun Chokkalingam**

**Dr. Arun Chokkalingam is Professor of Medicine and Global Health at the University of Toronto and founding director of Global Health at The National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute of the US National Institute of Health (NIH). He is passionate about global health research, particularly on prevention of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) and their control in Low and Middle Income Countries (LMIC). He has established research collaborations in all six continents including China and India. His multidisciplinary research interests, beyond cardiovascular health, include household air pollution; mental health; congruency of health, agriculture and economics; and smart villages. He has published 175+ papers; served as an editorial board member and reviewer for numerous journals. He has organized several national and international**

conferences in Canada and abroad and is a co-editor of the book "Smart Villages - Bridging the Global Urban-Rural Divide, recently published by Springer."

Don't miss the opportunity of listening to Dr. Arun Chokkalingam, professor of medicine and global health at University of Toronto.
