Handi-Care Int'l. (HCI) was founded as a registered charity in Canada in 1992 and since then we have focused on "Education, Rehabilitation and Vocational Training" of poor rural disabled children and youth. There are **233 such children and 30 youth under our full sponsorship and over 525 mentally or physically challenged individuals are the beneficiaries** of various rehabilitation programs we have initiated. More than 130 children and 130 disabled youth have successfully graduated from our initiatives and are gainfully employed. We concentrate equally on educating and creating awareness in the surrounding community both ethically and socially.

HCI is a volunteer driven organization. By keeping the administrative costs to the minimum, **HCI has consistently achieved a disbursement rate in excess of 97% to charitable activities.**

- Our Mission: To raise awareness about and Empower persons with disabilities through Education, Rehabilitation and Vocational training.
- Our Mandate: Relieving poverty by providing housing and related facilities for people with special needs as well as people who are destitute; relieving suffering due to disability by providing facilities for the care, maintenance, and rehabilitation; establishing and operating schools for higher education and for vocational training of the disabled.

HCI achieves its goals by working with organizations that fulfill all the criteria it sets forth, with high expectations of commitment, reputability, accountability and efficiency. HCI funds these organizations for specific projects and works hand in hand with them to ensure implementation and to keep the project under check. The chief among them are **AMAR SEVA SANGAM (ASSA)**, a nationally acclaimed organization, **and Maithri** in South India.

Our achievements

- Built an "Early Intervention Centre" at Amar Seva Sangam (2012) for children from 0 to 5 years of age, with developmental delays
- Built a school expansion at ASSA (2012), with more classrooms and a lab to accommodate the growing number of students. Currently, the school has an integrated enrollment of more than 900 students.
- Established Volunteer / Clinical Placements for OT/PT graduates from Canada: Selected students from Canadian Universities are placed at ASSA every year, leading to credits towards their degree in Physio or Occupational therapy. Other volunteers are also placed. 2 professional OTs will be volunteering at ASSA for 2 months in early 2015. This will enhance the current treatment protocol at ASSA
- Built the "Centre For Special Education" (2009) which provides a full range of rehabilitation and educational programs for over 170 children with intellectual challenges.
- Re-built a village in South India that was demolished by the 2004 Tsunami.
 Constructed 17 homes and resettled the families.
- 233 children are under current sponsorships. In addition, 121 children have successfully completed schooling and are employed.
- 30 disabled youth are sponsored yearly for higher studies or vocational training. 150 youth under HCI's sponsorships have completed studies and are placed in gainful employment, since 2004.

Current focus: "Early Intervention" of developmentally challenged children from ages 0 to 5

Since the project's inception in 2012, 300 children are enrolled in that program. HCI donors have sponsored 30 of these children. Our goal is to sponsor another 100 in the next 2 years. Sankara Raman is Amar Seva Sangam's (ASSA) Honorary Secretary and the driving force behind this revolutionary institution's success. Under Sankara Raman's leadership, ASSA has become a premier rehabilitation and education facility for people with disabilities in rural India. Affected by muscular dystrophy, Sankara Raman has been a wheel-chair user since the age of 12. He overcame many obstacles, including social stigmas and limited access to support services, to become a successful chartered accountant (CA). A turning point in his life occurred in 1990 when he decided to leave his CA practice in order to be a full-time social entrepreneur and advocate for those with disabilities. He has won several awards and recognitions, including the President of India's award, CNN Hero, Super idol (2010). In October 2014, through the help of Handi-Care Intl. volunteers, Sankara Raman and ASSA entered into a partnership with the Government of Canada through Grand Challenges Canada which is dedicated to supporting Bold Ideas with Big Impact[®]. Through this exciting partnership, ASSA will create innovative technology applications and telecommunications which will enable access to early intervention therapy for children with delayed development throughout rural India.

Waseem is a 4 year old boy who was first seen by Amar Seva Sangam field workers at the age of 1. His parents had noticed frequent falls and balance issues, but did not realize that there were any developmental issues. ASSA's field workers measured a large head circumference and immediately referred him to ASSA's medical team who made the diagnosis of hydrocephalus (a condition characterized by too much fluid in the brain). Arrangements were made for an operation to shunt the fluid out of his brain and thanks to a Handi-Care Intl donor's sponsorship, he was enrolled in ASSA's early intervention (EI) program, where he received therapy to improve his mobility and cognitive development. He was given AFOs (ankle foot orthotics) to improve his muscle strength and now he is able to sit and stand independently. Due to his rapid improvement in development with EI therapy, he has been successfully integrated into a local nursery school where he enjoys learning and playing alongside his peers.

Deepak Lal (Left) grew up in Uttaranchal and was orphaned at an early age after his parents died in a bus accident. Tragedy struck again in his youth, when he was involved in a car accident that caused a spinal injury and left him paralyzed from neck down. He was languishing in a government hospital with severe bed sores, when a Handi-Care Intl. supporter told him about Amar Seva Sangam and sponsored his rehabilitation. He received excellent nursing care, plastic surgery for his bed sores and daily physiotherapy, yoga therapy and vocational training. His upper extremity strength has improved and he now operates a motorized wheelchair. He also learned the Tamil language and now works for Amar Seva Sangam as an email promoter and office manager. His goal is to help others with disabilities enjoy the success he has achieved.

Her mother was also educated about her condition and was taught how to provide early intervention techniques at home. Mahalakshmi has made immense gains, including learning how to speak and walk with support. Mohan was approximately 6 months old when his parents noticed that he was having delayed milestones. Doctors at the local government hospital reassured his parents repeatedly. However, at the age of 2, he was unable to communicate and had behavioural difficulties. His mother then joined a women's self-help group and the group leader referred Mohan to Amar Seva Sangam's early intervention program. He was diagnosed with cerebral palsy and was enrolled in ASSA's early intervention program and was sponsored by a donor through Handi-Care Intl. The focus of his early intervention education plan (EIEP) was on communication and behavioural therapy. After 2 years of therapy, he has learned to speak and is independent with a number of activities including feeding. He has also had significant improvement in his behaviour. Mohan has been successfully integrated into the local primary school, where he is able to interact with teachers and children without parental supervision.

David suffered a spinal cord injury after a fall from a tree that left him paraplegic at the age of 12. Coming from a family with minimal resources and education, he received no surgical treatment or rehabilitation. He was bedridden with no bowel or bladder control and completely dependent in all activities of daily living. Thanks to Handi-Care Intl.'s support, he was admitted to ASSA's spinal cord rehabilitation centre in 2009. After 1 year of intensive rehabilitation provided for free, he learned self- catheterization, wheelchair / tricycle propulsion and bowel management. He was also provided vocational training in cell phone repair. He is now a successful entrepreneur who is fully independent in his Activities of Daily Living, running his own cell phone spare parts and service business.

Handi-Care Intl.'s clinical placement program has been one of our most successful undertakings. We now have affiliations with University of British Columbia, McGill University, Western University, Queens University, McMaster University and University of Manitoba to provide accredited 6-8 week clinical placements at the Amar Seva Sangam campus for graduate students of Physiotherapy and Occupational therapy. Students have not only gained immensely from the experience, but have made significant contributions. For example, Melanie conducted courses on wheelchair safety, work related back and neck pain prevention and home adaptations. In 2015, OT students from Canada will be accompanied by registered OTs from Canada during their clinical placement in India.

From a single endowment of \$160, this program continues to feed ASSA children every year. Another very successful program is The Campus Feeding which is a one time sponsorship that feeds 300 children on a special day of your choice for \$200. We have over 360 MFAD sponsorships that celebrate our donors' special days. Every year close to 10,000 meals are served to children with disabilities, thanks to Handi-care Intl's supporters.

Thanks to generous Handi-Care Intl. donors from Canada, the construction of a barrier free high school facility has allowed more than 100 students to attend this integrated high school where disabled students learn alongside their peers. These two girls, who otherwise may not have attended high school, have achieved extraordinary success at ASSA's integrated high school. They plan on going to university to study engineering and education.

Ways you can participate and help - HCI

Adopt A Child (AAC): \$350 a year or 3 endowments of \$1800 (Interest utilized), will provide a disabled child with home care, food, clothing, education (Integrated), and rehabilitation services such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy.

Adopt on Early Intervention Child: \$400 a year or an endowment of \$2000 (Interest utilized), will provide complete Early Intervention services (special therapies, equipments and home follow up) to a child between age 0 to 5 and at that point the sponsorship will move on to another child.

Meal For A Day (MFAD): Interest earned on a one time donation of \$160 will sponsor the meals of 25 disabled children on a chosen date every year.

Campus / Mini campus Feeding : You can celebrate your special day by choosing the Mini feeding plan. For \$200, the 300 children will receive a special lunch. For \$400, the entire campus of about 600 people, including staff, children & youth receive a special lunch on the date of your choice.

Sponsor A Youth (SAY): \$600 a year will sponsor the complete care of a disabled youth who undergoes higher education and/or vocational training, leading to gainful employment.

Go Dhaan (Donate a cow) – For \$1000, you can donate a milk yielding young cow with a calf. The cow will produce milk and milk products for the residing and day care (Close to 300) children for several years.

Rehabilitate A Person with Spinal Cord Injury (RSI) : \$4000 a year will sponsor one year's rehabilitation for a patient with spinal cord injury. Each patient receives 4 hrs of daily physiotherapy, a personal attendant, vocational training, counselling, and complete medical care, which may including surgery and hospitalization.

General : Any amount, which will go a long way to fund all rehab activities.
