Dear Friends, Donors and supporters of Handi-Care Intl.,



DEDICATED TO SERVING THE POOR and DIFFERENTLY ABLED

Handi-Care Intl. (HCI) was founded as a registered charity in Canada in 1992 and since then we have focused on “Education, Rehabilitation and Vocational Training” of poor rural disabled children and youth. There are currently **345 such children and youth under our full sponsorship and over 700 mentally or physically challenged individuals** have successfully graduated from our initiatives and are gainfully employed or successfully integrated with the society. We concentrate equally on educating and creating awareness in the surrounding community both ethically and socially.

HCI is a volunteer driven organization. By keeping the administrative costs to 2 to 3%, HCI has consistently achieved a disbursement rate in excess of 97% to charitable activities.

- ❖ **Our Mission:** To raise awareness about and Empower persons with disabilities through Education, Rehabilitation and Vocational training.
- ❖ **Our Mandate:** Relieving poverty by providing housing and related facilities for people with special needs as well as people who are in need; relieving suffering due to disability by providing facilities for the care, maintenance, and rehabilitation; establishing and operating schools for higher education and for vocational training of the disabled.

HCI achieves its goals by working with organizations that fulfill all the criteria it sets forth, with high expectations of commitment, reputability, accountability and efficiency. HCI funds these organizations for specific projects and works hand in hand with them to ensure implementation and to keep the project under check. The chief among them are **AMAR SEVA SANGAM (ASSA) – www.amarseva.org, an award winning and nationally acclaimed organization, and Maithri Educational trust, in South India.**

WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED SO FAR?

- ❖ Started supporting medical and rehab services for Canadian children with Cerebral Palsy in 2016. 4 children have received support for a special SDR surgery, available only in the USA and many are on the wait list.
- ❖ **Initiated “Early Intervention program”** and built a centre at Amar Seva Sangam (2012) for children from 0 to 6 years of age, born with developmental delays, Cerebral Palsy etc. The centre now serves over **448 children and has expanded to 11 centres in the rural area. HCI donors have sponsored 105 children and our goal is to sponsor another 100 in the near future.**
- ❖ **Built an extension of high school at ASSA (2012)**, with more classrooms and a lab to accommodate the growing number of students. Currently, the school educates about 900 students. HCI has facilitated the integration of special needs students into the school.
- ❖ **Higher education and Vocational training of youth with special needs –** HCI has sponsored students with special needs since 2002 and **158 of them have completed and are well employed**
- ❖ **Established Volunteer / Clinical Placements for OT/PT graduates from Canada:** Selected students from major universities across Canada are placed at ASSA every year, leading to a credit towards their degree in Physiotherapy or Occupational therapy. Professional OT supervisors are volunteering their precious time and skills at ASSA since 2014, which is making a huge impact in the rehab of children and adults. **49 students and professionals were placed in 2015-16.**
- ❖ **Built the “Centre for Special Education” (2009)** which provides a full range of rehabilitation and educational programs. **Currently 89 children** with developmental challenges are under our sponsorship and **92 children** have successfully completed the program thru us.
- ❖ An average of **80,000** meals is served under our sponsorship every year.

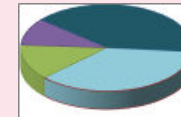

What have we done with your donations

HCI funds highly reputable, dedicated and accountable Non Governmental Organizations for chosen projects that fall under the mandate. HCI also develops initiatives for NGOs through the implementation of attractive and viable plans.

Handi-Care Intl. has consistently maintained its operating expenses at an average of below 3%

- ❖ **HCI has disbursed \$ 1.5 Million to rural projects in India since 1992**
- ❖ **\$ 718,000** in endowments and in yearly payments towards Adopt A Child, Meal For A Day and other educational programs.
- ❖ **\$ 465,000** disbursed to ASSA & CREED for various building projects.
- ❖ **\$170,000** to support the higher education of almost 250 disabled youth.
- ❖ **\$131,000** (2009-2016) for the intensive rehab of spinal cord injured.

Current focus for Early Intervention program

The Early Intervention Program provides rehabilitation for underprivileged children under the age of 6 who have delayed development, Cerebral Palsy etc. We have **448 children** under this program and in order to sustain their rehab in the coming year, we need to raise funds. Early intervention has proven to dramatically improve a child's development and long-term quality of life. **Our goal is to raise \$200,000 in the next 12 months to support the existing program and to add more children at ASSA's EI Centres. A sponsorship of \$400 per year or an endowment of \$2000 per child will support the costs of therapy, new equipment, well-trained and skilled therapists, transportation, and a variety of other expenses.**

Village Based Rehabilitation Early Intervention Program



Handi-Care Intl. had secured \$110,000 in funding from the Government of Canada, through Grand Challenges Canada (GCC) in 2014 for a village based rehabilitation program that provides 351 children with early intervention therapy through Amar Seva Sangam. The program outcome is very impressive and GCC has tentatively agreed to match all donations up to \$600,000 to Handi-Care Intl. for this program over the next 3 years. For more info, visit:









EI therapy aims to improve development in motor, occupational, cognitive, social, and speech function to help children reach their full potential. Our goal is to raise \$200,000 in the next 12 months to support the existing program and to add more children at ASSA's EI Centres. Generous donors of HCI have sponsored 105 children and we have another 257 on the wait list. 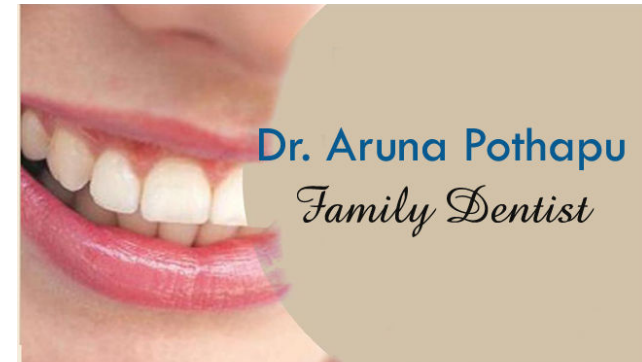
Centre for Special Education.

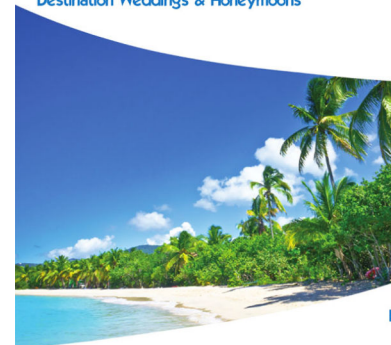

Selective Dorsal Rhizotomy (SDR) is a surgery that helps reduce spasticity in children with cerebral palsy. The surgery can help children improve their mobility and transition between positions, making some of the activities of daily living easier. This surgery is not offered in Ontario or covered by provincial health plans. Therefore, Handi-Care Intl. has sponsored 4 children to cover some of their expenses of having the surgery done at St.Louis Children's Hospital in USA and Post surgery rehab in Ontario.
