Some of the ongoing activities which still need funding support to execute are:

- Protective material (face masks, hand sanitizers & hand wash for the people with disabilities as many are in direct physical contact with caregivers and support workers. Each kit is C\$1.50.
- Salaries for the vulnerable community workers for 3 months C\$46,000
- At the Special School (Centre for Special Education where most of the children are sponsored by HCI donors), the teachers and therapists are providing activity-based virtual/online classes and training to the students and to their parents to carry out the regular activities which are essential for the growth of the child.
