significant reduction in the 'caregiver strain' is evident as these children are becoming independent in attending their personal needs.


- Substantial increase in school enrolment has been achieved by creating community awareness programs and through advocacy for accessibility in schools.

Handi-Care Intl. (HCI) is pleased to announce that we have been awarded with a grant of US\$15,000 by Million Dollar Round Table. Due to COVID-19, home visits have not been possible. The grant will be directed towards purchasing smartphones and tablets for rehab workers to be connected to our tele-rehab services, as well as for assistive devices for children. Now our program is being scaled up to several more districts in Tamilnadu, India, and we are enrolling 4000 more children. Hence, this award will be of great value to us.

She had a score of 3% of normal in all areas, such as Special Education, Physio, Speech and Functional independence.
