As you know, Handi-Care Intl. supports the Amar Seva Sangam, India, which houses integrated schools with dormitory accommodation for children with special needs, vocational training centers, and multi-faceted rehabilitation centers. During this pandemic,

social distancing norms can not that easily be followed by people with special needs as they require assistance from staff around the clock at close proximity. Safety, health, and hygiene of people with special needs and their caregivers are particularly important which we administer through staggered work shifts, limiting the number of people using the space and contacts, etc..

Amar Seva Sangam supports about 20 000 people with special needs in 7 municipalities in its catchment area. During the 1st wave of the pandemic, it has served safety kits, non-perishable food, medications and conducted awareness programs to more than 1600 families identified as the neediest of them. The present second wave is affecting a much larger number of people. Please support Amar Seva Sangam's initiative to provide safety kits, medications, oxygen supply, and non-perishable food for about 5000 of those people with special needs who are either single, living alone, profoundly disabled with dependency on caregivers, elderly, or from poor families.
