He has established research collaborations in all six continents including China and India. His multidisciplinary research interests, beyond cardiovascular health, include household air pollution; mental health; congruency of health, agriculture, and economics; and smart villages. He has published 175+ papers; served as an editorial board member and reviewer for numerous journals. He has organized several national and international conferences in Canada and abroad and is a co-editor of the book "Smart Villages - Bridging the Global Urban-Rural Divide, recently published by Springer."
